Made from locally-sourced, sustainable timber, this light and airy building set in a designated Site of Biological Importance is the perfect venue for a motivational and uplifting day away from the office.

By hiring the space you'll also be supporting Groundwork, a not-for-profit organisation working to support Greater Manchester communities.



LAYOUT

The building layout is made up of soft seating at the front, a large open meeting space in the middle, kitchenette and work surface at the rear and through the doors at the far rear two toilets.

The main area can be arranged in a variety of layouts and comfortably sits between 10-20 people.

BY CAR

We have a small free car park on site as well as free roadside parking on Lake Road.

For sat nav use **Trafford Ecology Park** as a postcode only search will take you to our neighbours Muller at the end of Lake Road; we are located half way down Lake Road on the right hand side when turning off Trafford Park Road.



BY BUS

From Manchester City Centre take service number X50 or 250.

Alight at Village Way and walk 10 minutes down Trafford Park Road turning onto Lake Road to reach Trafford Ecology Park.



BY TRAM

Trafford Ecology Park is situated in between two Metrolink stations on the Trafford Park Line; Imperial War Museum North and Village, as well as the MediaCityUK stop via footbridges.

These stops are approximately 15 minutes walk from Trafford Ecology Park.



BY BIKE

There is a secure bike shed on site which can be accessed on request.
